

VIKING UNION WEB DEVELOPER 4

DESCRIPTION:

VU Web Application Developers are responsible for developing and maintaining web-based software for the Viking Union and Associated Students. Applications are developed in a Unix-like environment using a variety of programming languages and technologies, such as Python (using the Django MVC Framework), Javascript/JQuery, and HTML/CSS.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be self-motivated and passionate about computing technologies
- Must be proficient in at least one object-oriented programming language.
- Must have a demonstrated knowledge of Web Architecture
- Must be able to present and discuss a coding sample

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience with shell scripting
- Experience with Git, SVN, Team Foundation, or other Version Control systems
- Experience developing in an MVC Framework (Python/Django, Ruby/Rails, Groovy/Grails, PHP/Zend, etc.)

All qualified students are encouraged to apply. However, preference will be given to students who have more than three academic quarters remaining before graduating.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop and maintain web-based software under the supervision of the IT Manager and the Lead Developer.
- Work with a cross-functional development team to collaborate on server-side application code, front-end design and development, and quality assurance testing.
- Maintain work schedule as assigned by the IT Manager.
- Check with the Lead Developer on a regular basis for job assignments.
- Maintain a courteous and helpful attitude, and maintain a good working relationship with Viking Union staff, Associated Students staff, and various clubs and organizations.

- Complete and submit all time sheets to the IT Manager.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

REPORTS TO: Viking Union IT Manager

SCHEDULE: Fall, Winter, and Spring: 19 hours per week. Summer work may be available but is not guaranteed at this time.

SALARY LEVEL: \$11.50 per hour
