Lakewood is the Associated Students multi-use facility located on the south shore of Lake Whatcom. There is a boathouse with canoes, kayaks, row boats and sailboats that can be used for a small fee by members of the Western Community.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Conduct classes, at Lakewood, that cover both theoretical and practical aspects of small boat sailing.
2. By the use "dry land" discussions and "on the water" practice sessions, the instructor shall provide the students with training necessary to pass the Lakewood sailing certification exam.

Qualifications:

Must be a full time student of Western (10 credits) during spring and fall quarters. Must be able to lift 65 pounds.

RECOMMENDED QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Have a sound knowledge of aero- and hydro- dynamics, as applicable to small boat sailing.
2. Have several seasons' experience with sailing small boats.
3. Be able to communicate and demonstrate the proper techniques involved with small boat sailing.
4. Have knowledge of the rigging of all of Lakewood's sailboats.
5. Have a US Sailing Level 1 Dinghy Instructors certificate.
